

7 Day itinerary

Day 1 - Bonifacio - Lavezzi Archipelago

Afternoon departure from Bonifacio, followed by a short sail to the Lavezzi islands, around 10 km away. Anchor in the bay of Cala Lazarina, a sheltered spot ideal for a first swim. You'll discover spectacular granite boulders and small sandy coves surrounding the main island. Spend the night at anchor in this wilderness area, classified as a nature reserve.

Day 2 - Lavezzi Archipelago - Maddalena Archipelago

After breakfast on board, set sail for the Maddalena archipelago in Sardinia, around 2h30 away. You'll arrive on the island of Spargi, anchored in Cala Corsara, a bay sheltered from the north-westerly wind and surrounded by rocks sculpted by erosion. The coves can only be explored by dinghy. The night is spent at anchor in absolute calm.

Day 3 - Maddalena - Isola di Caprera

Sail to the island of Caprera, located in the heart of a nature reserve. Anchor in Cala Coticcio, nicknamed "Tahiti", accessible only by sea. Its high granite cliffs offer excellent shelter from the wind. An excursion ashore can be organized to explore the island's nature trails. Overnight at anchor.






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Suggested 7-day itinerary in Corsica

Back to Corsica, with around 2 hours' sailing to reach the bay of Rondinara. Anchorage is in the central cove, which is perfectly protected from prevailing winds thanks to the bay's rounded shape. The sandy bottom provides solid anchorage. During the day, enjoy the beach or the calm on board, while the catamaran remains stable in these calm waters. Spectacular sunsets guaranteed!

Departure for Santa Giulia after a short sail. Anchor near the central pontoon, where the shallow water offers easy anchorage. Enjoy a peaceful day in this long, well-protected bay, ideal for a paddle outing or to easily reach the beach restaurants with the dinghy. The clear sandy bottom provides good visibility for snorkeling.

Back to Bonifacio, with an option to anchor for lunch at Punta de Sperone. This spot is well sheltered from the westerly wind and provides an excellent vantage point for a breathtaking view of the Lavezzi in the background. Arrive in Bonifacio harbor in the afternoon to take advantage of the marina's services and enjoy a lively evening ashore



14-day itinerary

Day 1 and 2 - Bonifacio - Lavezzi Archipelago

A short sail takes you to the Lavezzi, an archipelago classified as a nature reserve. Spend the afternoon exploring the islets aboard the dinghy or on foot. Scuba diving enthusiasts can admire the biodiversity of the seabed. Anchor at Cala di Giunco.

Day 3 - Lavezzi Archipelago - Maddalena Archipelago

Sailing to the national park of the Maddalena archipelago. Anchor at Cala Corsara, on the island of Spargi, and hike along trails with panoramic views of the archipelago. Take advantage of water sports to explore the various secluded coves!

Day 4 : Île de Spargi - Isola di Caprera


A short sail takes you to the island of Caprera, where you can anchor at Cala Brigantina. This unspoilt site is perfect for paddle-boarding and hiking.





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Suggested 14-day itinerary Corsica - Sardinia



Anchor off the island of Mortorio, a protected area. Discover its hidden coves by paddle. Admire the seabirds or explore the surrounding waters by snorkeling.

Sail to the island of Tavolara, famous for its spectacular mountainous terrain. Hike to the peaks for breathtaking views and enjoy a meal based on local produce in the island's only restaurant.

Sailing to La Caletta in Sardinia. Stroll through this authentic village and visit the Spanish tower, or organize a bike or electric scooter outing in the surrounding area

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Day 5 : Caprera - Isola di Mortorio

Day 9 : Caletta - Cala Goloritzé

Sail to the Golfo di Orosei, anchoring at Cala Goloritzé, a UNESCO World Heritage beach. Spend the day swimming, diving or exploring this cove of turquoise waters and impressive cliffs.

Day 10 - 11 : Cala Goloritzé - Rondinara Bay (Corsica)

Back to Corsica. Stop off at Rondinara Bay, a sheltered spot where you can explore the surrounding area on foot or paddleboard.

Departure for Santa Giulia after a short sail. Anchor near the central pontoon. Enjoy a peaceful day in this long, well-protected bay, ideal for a paddle outing or to easily reach the beach restaurants by dinghy. The clear sandy bottom provides good visibility for snorkeling and wingfoiling.

Cap retour vers Bonifacio, avec une option de mouillage pour le déjeuner à la Punta de Sperone. Ce spot est bien abrité du vent et constitue un excellent point pour profiter d'une vue imprenable sur les Lavezzi en arrière-plan. Arrivée au port de Bonifacio dans l'après-midi pour profiter des services de la marina et d'une dernière soirée animée à terre.
